

Václav Pichl: Sinfonia in F, Z5

This edition is based on a set of undated parts in Národní museum in Prague (shelf number *XLIII C 312.*) The inscription on the wrapper sheet reads “Sinfonia in F: | à | Due Violini | Due Oboe | Due Corni| Alto Viola | con| Basso. | Del Signre Pichl. | Pro Choro F. Frm | Misericordiae Kukusii.” The parts as they are currently assembled in the wrapper are: Basso (B), Violino Primo (V1), Violino Secondo (V2), Alto Viola (Va), Oboe Primo (O1), Oboe Secondo (O2), Corno 1:mo in F (H1), Corno 2:do in F (H2). The parts have some missing bars or duplicated bars, and are annotated in the report below. The copyist was not the most reliable; missing and duplicated bars occur in several parts. Dynamics, accent marks and slurs are inconsistent, even sometimes within a part, seemingly to no particular purpose; these have been standardised without comment. Editorial additions are bracketed.

The following changes were made (bar number, part, position of symbol in bar, original reading; references to note pitch uses the Helmholtz notation system.):
